

YOUTH WORKER / INTERN

(May be taken for contextual ministry credit)

Primary Focus

Equip the church, especially the youth, to love and worship God, to be transformed as we grow in Christ, to make visible the Kingdom of God as we serve Atlanta and the world.

<u>Time Required:</u> 5-10 hours per week starting in August of 2024 and going through May of 2025 (it will mainly be 5 hours/week plus retreats!)

<u>Compensation</u>: \$14/hour for a youth worker or 400 hours credit for contextual ministry students (you are welcome to get both if the school allows it!)

Responsibilities

- Attend morning worship at NAPC, occasionally engaging in worship leadership.
- Assist in the planning and execution of youth ministry programming/operations:
 - o Sunday Morning Discipleship (weekly, year-round)
 - Sunday Night Youth (about 8 a semester)
 - Weekly youth leadership team meetings
 - Special Events (Retreats, Family Worship, Mission Trips, Camps)
- Meeting with the Youth Director for personal development, reflection, and prayer.
- Assist with social media management of accounts.
- Engage in other duties as may be mutually determined with supervisors.

• Contagious faith, Passion to engage youth in Christian living, Character above reproach, Desire to minister on a collaborative team.
